

issue bonds or notes therefor under the provisions of chapter twenty-seven of the Revised Laws, or otherwise, in the same manner and to the same extent as if the special authority therefor contained in the said special acts had not been granted.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE PROBATE COURT HOUSE IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE. *Chap.325*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Middlesex may expend a sum not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars for the purpose of completing the unfinished part of the probate court house at Cambridge and in furnishing the same. Completion of the probate court house at Cambridge.

SECTION 2. To meet the expenses incurred under this act the county commissioners may borrow from time to time on the credit of said county a sum not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars, and may issue the bonds, notes or scrip of the county therefor, payable at a date not later than the first day of July in the year nineteen hundred and twenty, and bearing interest, payable semi-annually, at a rate not exceeding four per cent per annum. Said bonds, notes or scrip shall be payable in such annual proportionate payments as will extinguish the same within the time prescribed in this act, and they shall not be sold or pledged for less than the par value thereof. The county of Middlesex may issue bonds, etc.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ASSIGNMENT OF ROOMS IN THE STATE HOUSE. *Chap.326*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The governor, with the advice and consent of the council, may assign the rooms in the state house and rooms elsewhere, used by the commonwealth, and may determine the occupancy thereof in such manner as the public service may from time to time require: *provided*, that this Assignment of rooms in the state house, etc.
