SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE MATRON IN THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS' DEPARTMENT AT THE STATE HOUSE. Chap.182

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The compensation of the matron in the state house shall be eleven hundred dollars a year. Matron in state house, salary established.

SECTION 2. The increase in salary provided for by this act shall not take effect until an appropriation has been made sufficient to cover the same, and then as of the first day of June in the current year. Time of taking effect.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE CLERK IN CHARGE OF THE LEGISLATIVE DOCUMENT ROOM. Chap.183

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk in charge of the legislative document room in the state house shall be eight-hundred dollars a year. Clerk in charge of legislative document room, salary established.

SECTION 2. The increase in salary provided for by this act shall not take effect until an appropriation has been made sufficient to cover the same, and then as of the first day of June in the current year. Time of taking effect.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF THE COURT OFFICERS OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE ROXBURY DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON. Chap.184

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The court officers of the municipal court of the Roxbury district of the city of Boston shall each be allowed by the county of Suffolk an annual salary of nine-hundred dollars. Court officers of municipal court of Roxbury district of city of Boston, salaries established.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city council of the city of Boston with the approval of the mayor. To be submitted to city council, etc.
