

Chap. 194. AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE UNITARIAN CONGREGATIONAL SOCIETY IN BARNSTABLE VILLAGE TO THE UNITARIAN CHURCH OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The name of the Unitarian Congregational Society in Barnstable Village, a religious corporation, is hereby changed to the Unitarian Church of Barnstable.

Chap. 195. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE WHICH THE SPRINGFIELD HOSPITAL MAY HOLD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 1 of the acts of 1930 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5, the word "ten" and inserting in place thereof the word:— twenty-five, — so as to read as follows:— The Springfield Hospital, a corporation incorporated under general law December twenty-fourth, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, is hereby authorized to hold, for the purposes for which it is incorporated, real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding twenty-five million dollars.

Chap. 196. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY WHICH MAY BE HELD BY THE MASONIC EDUCATION AND CHARITY TRUST.

Be it enacted, e.c., as follows:

Chapter 24 of the Special Acts of 1916 is hereby amended by striking out section 1, as amended by chapter 171 of the acts of 1951, and inserting in place thereof the following section:— *Section 1.* The Masonic Education and Charity Trust may hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding twenty million dollars.

Chap. 197. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF SAVINGS ACCOUNTS STANDING IN THE NAMES OF MINORS IN NATIONAL BANKING ASSOCIATIONS, SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATIONS OR FEDERAL CREDIT UNIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 48 of chapter 167 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 105 of the acts of 1961, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:—

Money deposited in the name of a minor in a national banking association, savings and loan association or federal credit union may, at the discretion of the treasurer or other authorized officer of such association or credit union, be paid to such minor or to his legal representative or, if the amount of such deposit does not exceed seven hundred and fifty dollars, to either parent of such minor, and any such payment shall discharge the liability of the association or credit union to all persons to the extent of such payments.
