

**Chap. 339.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF THE LICENSING BOARD OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD TO TRANSFER CERTAIN LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM PREMISES TAKEN FOR INTERSTATE ROUTE 195.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. In the case of any license granted under section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws to do business on premises located within five hundred feet, measured along public ways, of a church or school, as defined in section sixteen C of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, which have been taken by the commonwealth of Massachusetts for the purposes of interstate Route 195 by instrument dated September third, nineteen hundred and sixty-three and recorded with Bristol County, Southern District, Registry of Deeds Book 1421, Page 199, the licensing board for the city of New Bedford in addition to any and all other powers which it may have to transfer any such license, may transfer any such license to any other premises located within five hundred feet, measured along public ways, of a church or school, notwithstanding the limitations of section sixteen C of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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**Chap. 340.** AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CORRECTIVE CHANGES IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO CHILDREN'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FURNISHED TO THEIR AGED PARENTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Paragraph 3 of section 30 of chapter 118A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 597 of the acts of 1962, the words "forty-seven hundred and fifty" and inserting in place thereof the words: — six thousand.

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**Chap. 341.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSTING OF CIVIL SERVICE SENIORITY LISTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 15C of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 195 of the acts of 1953, is hereby further amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

Every such appointing officer shall cause a copy of such list signed by him to be posted forthwith in a prominent place in the department for inspection on or before May first in the year in which the list of officers and employees is compiled. Such list shall be dated as of the day of posting and shall remain posted for one year from the date of posting.
