

Chap. 179. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE TYPE OF REGISTRATION TO BE ISSUED TO CERTAIN PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 234 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by striking out in line 2, the words "temporary license to practice" and inserting in place thereof the words: — limited registration for the practice of

Chap. 180. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSTOWN TO PAY CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES AND RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF SAID TOWN AS COMPENSATION FOR UNUSED VACATION TIME

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, and in order to discharge a moral obligation of the town of Williamstown, said town may pay to the following named employees and retired employees of said town the sums set forth after their respective names as compensation for unused vacation time — Maynard J Austin, four hundred eighty dollars and seventy-six cents, Earl George, four hundred ninety-two dollars and thirty cents; J. Elwood Lamphear, four hundred sixty-three dollars and forty-two cents; Charles Notsley, three hundred twelve dollars and sixty-eight cents; Agnes Roy, one hundred twenty-four dollars and forty cents; and Evelyn Card, eighty-six dollars and forty cents.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the town of Williamstown.

Chap. 181. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE DISTRICT COURT OF LEE AND THE DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN BERKSHIRE EXERCISE CONCURRENT JURISDICTION IN THE TOWN OF STOCKBRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the third paragraph under the caption "*Berkshire*", as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

The district court of southern Berkshire, held at Great Barrington; Sheffield, Great Barrington, Egremont, Alford, Mount Washington, Monterey, New Marlborough, Stockbridge, West Stockbridge and Sandisfield; the district court of Lee exercising concurrent jurisdiction in Sandisfield and Stockbridge

SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 218 is hereby further amended by striking out the fifth paragraph under the caption "*Berkshire*", as so appearing, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

The district court of Lee, held at Lee; Lee, Stockbridge, Tyringham, Otis, Sandisfield, Lenox and Becket; the district court of southern Berkshire exercising concurrent jurisdiction in Sandisfield and Stockbridge, and the district court of central Berkshire exercising concurrent jurisdiction in Lenox and Becket
