

Chap. 277. AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE CERTIFICATION OF OPERATORS OF WASTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 87BBBB of chapter 112 of the General Laws, inserted by section 2 of chapter 781 of the acts of 1970, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 7, the word "seventy-three" and inserting in place thereof the word: — sixty-six A. *Approved May 10, 1971.*

Chap. 278. AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THE THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTING CERTAIN EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS AND FOR CERTAIN NEW ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act and for certain new activities and projects, the sums set forth in section two of this act are hereby appropriated from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in the item, subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter four hundred and eighty of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy for the fiscal year ending June the thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, or for such period as may be specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition to any amounts at present available for the purposes.

SECTION 2.

1902-5000	For a medical assistance program; provided, that all federal funds received for the purpose of this item shall be credited to the General Fund (1969, 800); and provided further, that no expenditure or commitment made pursuant to this item or to any agreements authorized by said chapter eight hundred for the purpose of complying with the provisions of Public Law 89-97, Title XIX shall be incurred in excess of available funds which have been appropriated therefor, prior appropriation continued	\$17,000,000
1903-2000	For a program of aid to families with dependent children; provided, that all federal funds received for the purpose of this item shall be credited to the General Fund, including prior year expenses	27,008,140
1906-2000	For a program of general relief, including prior year charges; provided, that notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, no increase in the budgetary standard allowance, so-called, shall be granted or paid unless such increase shall have been approved in advance by the commissioner of administration after certification by the budget director that funds are available for said increase; and, provided further, that said commissioner shall notify in writing the house and senate committees on ways and means thirty days prior to the effective date of said increase	3,119,980

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
