

Thence Running S $5^{\circ} - 53' - 50''$ W, 150.00 feet to a point;

Thence Running N $84^{\circ} - 06' - 10''$ W, 150.00 feet to a point;

Thence Running N $5^{\circ} - 53' - 50''$ E, 150.00 feet to a point;

The last three courses being by land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts;

Thence Running S $84^{\circ} - 06' - 10''$ E, 150.00 feet along said Hill Street to the point of beginning.

The above described tract contains 22,500 square feet and is a portion of the land taken by the commonwealth in an order of taking dated June 21, 1961 from Viola Berg et al and recorded at the Worcester district registry of deeds in Worcester county on June 21, 1961 in Book 4201 Page 433.

Said tracts of land were taken by the commonwealth through its water resources commission by virtue of the authority conferred by chapter six hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty, for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining certain flood control and flood retardation works of improvement.

The location and design of said sanitary sewer system shall be subject to the approval of the water resources commission.

Chap. 82. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PARK LAND IN THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON TO THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The park department of the town of Arlington is hereby authorized to transfer to the conservation commission of said town, the care, custody, management and control of certain park land located in said town known as Meadow Brook park, for any purpose contained in section eight C of chapter forty of the General Laws, said land being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southeasterly sideline of Mystic Valley Parkway, said point being the boundary line between Mt. Pleasant Cemetery and Meadow Brook Park, thence going northeasterly on said sideline of Mystic Valley Parkway on a curve to the right with a radius of 500.64 feet a distance of 402.85 feet to a point of compound curve, thence northeasterly on a curve to the right with a radius of 500.34 feet a distance of 239.15 feet to a point on said southeasterly sideline of Mystic Valley Parkway, thence S $55^{\circ} 51' 15''$ E on said southeasterly sideline of Mystic Valley Parkway a distance of 104.94 feet to a point on said southeasterly sideline of Mystic Valley Parkway at the present boundary line between Mt. Pleasant Cemetery and Meadow Brook Park, thence S $26^{\circ} 05' 05''$ W on said boundary line a distance of 420.69 feet, thence southwesterly on said boundary line

on a curve to the left with a radius of 240.00 feet a distance of 47 feet more or less to a point, said point being the boundary line between Mt. Pleasant Cemetery and Meadow Brook Park, thence going northwesterly on said boundary line a distance of 330 feet more or less to the point of beginning; said land being shown on a plan on file in the office of the Town Engineer, Arlington, Mass., entitled "Plan of Land in Arlington, Mass., to be transferred from Park to Cemetery, Scale 1" = 40', Nov. 25, 1949, James M. Keane, Town Engineer."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 83. AN ACT COMMITTING A CERTAIN AMOUNT RAISED BY TAXATION IN THE OXFORD-ROCHDALE SEWER DISTRICT FOR THE EIGHTEEN-MONTH FISCAL PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, AND ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the assessors of the towns of Oxford and Leicester in assessing taxes for the Oxford-Rochdale Sewer District for the fiscal year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, shall assess, in addition to the amount required to be assessed in accordance with the provisions of section twenty-three of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, their proportionate share of the sum of twenty-one thousand seventy-six dollars and ninety-four cents, said sum being approximately two thirds of the amount required to be raised by taxation in said Oxford-Rochdale Sewer District for the eighteen-month fiscal period beginning January first, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, and ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, but which was not committed to the town collectors of said towns in accordance with the provisions of section seven of chapter two hundred and fifty of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 84. AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION BECAUSE OF SEX OR MARITAL STATUS IN THE USE OF SUR-NAMES.
