SECTION 11. Sections two, three, four, five, seven, eight and ten of this act shall take effect on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty.

Chap. 28. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN SECTION OF CASTLE ISLAND LOCATED IN THE SOUTH BOSTON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE FIREFIGHTER ROBERT M. GREENE MEMORIAL PLAYGROUND AND PICNIC AREA.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The metropolitan district commission playground and picnic area located on the southerly side of Castle island in the South Boston district of the city of Boston shall be designated and known as the firefighter Robert M. Greene Memorial playground and picnic area in memory of firefighter Robert M. Greene of the fire department of the city of Boston who was killed in the line of duty on November twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight. A suitable marker bearing such designation may be attached thereto by the friends of said Robert M. Greene, provided that said marker conforms to the standards of said commission.

Chap. 29. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN OVERPASS IN THE CITY OF FALL RIVER AS THE MANUEL MICHAEL MEDEIROS OVERPASS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The state highway Route 1-195 overpass at Fourth and Pleasant streets in the city of Fall River shall be designated and known as the Manuel Michael Medeiros overpass, in memory of Manuel Michael Medeiros, who was instrumental in organizing the Construction and General Laborers' Union Local 610 of Fall River, and which he served as president, business manager and treasurer. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department and as authorized by the federal highway administration.
