

ACTS, 1980. - Chap. 327.

SECTION 11. Said chapter 548 is hereby further amended by inserting after section 7 the following section:-

Section 7A. Bonds issued by the commission under the provisions of this act are hereby made securities in which all insurance companies, trust companies in their commercial departments, savings banks, co-operative banks, banking associations, investment companies, executors, administrators, trustees and other fiduciaries may properly and legally invest funds, including capital in their control or belonging to them.

SECTION 12. This act shall take effect only upon its acceptance by all of the member city and towns of the commission, in the case of the city of North Adams, by vote of its city council approved by its mayor, and, in the case of the member towns, by vote of an annual or special town meeting in the respective towns.

Chap. 327. AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THE THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTING CERTAIN EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS AND FOR CERTAIN NEW ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act and for certain new activities and projects, the sums set forth in section two for the several purposes and subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter three hundred and ninety-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty or for such period as may be specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition to any amounts available for the purpose.

SECTION 2.

sand dollars may be expended for said medical services; and provided further that an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars may be expended from this item for expenses incurred in prior fiscal years

Chap. 328. AN ACT REGULATING ACCESS TO THE MASSACHUSETTS NATURAL HERITAGE PROGRAM DATA BASE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 66 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 17C the following section:-

Section 17D. Records of the department of environmental management known as the Massachusetts Natural Heritage Program Data Base shall not be public records; provided, however, that they shall be open for inspection by agents of the commonwealth preserving species and subspecies of nongame wildlife and indigenous plants.
