curve, bearing left with a radius of 462.52 feet, a distance of 80.98 feet, to a point (aka P.T.), thence:

S58°-30'-00"E on said sideline a distance of 299.15 feet to a point (aka P.C.) thence:

Easterly on said sideline on a curve to the left with a radius of 11.58 feet a distance of 30.00 feet to the point of beginning in the Westerly sideline of Maple St. (aka P.T.).

The reference plan used for the above described parcel is entitled Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Metropolitan District Commission, Water Division, Plan of Land in Marlborough, Mass., Scale 1 inch = 40 feet, May 24, 1928.

Said parcel is subject to a utility easement granted to the city of Marlborough, and recorded in the southern district registry of deeds in the county of Middlesex at Book 12787, Page 69, Plan #297 of 1975.

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Chap. 666. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION WALKWAY AT CLEVELAND CIRCLE IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE JUDGE MARGARET CAPABIANCO SCOTT MEMORIAL WALKWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The walkway at Cleveland circle in the Brighton district of the city of Boston shall be known and designated as the Judge Margaret Capabianco Scott Memorial walkway. A suitable tablet or marker bearing such designation shall be erected and maintained at said walkway by the metropolitan district commission.

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Chap. 667. AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND TO THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The division of capital planning and operations pursuant to section ten of chapter five hundred and seventy-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty, acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed to convey to the town of Framingham, grantee, at a price mutually agreeable to the parties all right, title, and interest which the common-

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wealth has in a certain parcel of land situated on Western avenue in said town of Framingham under the control of the department of corrections

Said parcel to be conveyed by a deed approved as to form by the attorney general, and subject to any presently existing leaseholds in said land bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point on the easterly side line of Western Avenue at the Framingham-Sherborn town line; thence

northerly along a curve to the right having a radius of 1751.76', a length of 121.48' along the easterly side line of Western Avenue to a point; thence

N-08-37'-00" E 1614.09' along the easterly side line of Western Avenue to a stone bound; thence

S-81-23'00" E 1467.06' by land of the commonwealth to a point in the center of Course Brook; thence

S-42-38'-00" W 1358.99' by land of the commonwealth and along the center of Course Brook to a point; thence

S-07-04'-00" W 299.70' by land of the commonwealth and along the center of Course Brook to a point on the Framingham-Sherborn town line; thence

S-75-05'-16" W 775.14' by land of the commonwealth and along the Framingham-Sherborn town line to the point of beginning.

Said parcel contains 35.5467 acres, more or less, and is shown on a plan entitled "Plan of Land in Framingham, Mass. owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, scale 1" = 80', dated February 20, 1980, survey by MacCarthy & Sullivan Engineering, Joseph R. Sullivan, Registered Land Surveyor".

Said parcel shall be used as a site for a central public works garage. In the event that said parcel is not used for such purposes within five years, the parcel shall revert to the commonwealth.

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Chap. 668. AN ACT DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF ROUTE 31 LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF ASHBY AS THE BURNHAM S. WALKER HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

That portion of the state highway known as Route 31 which is located in the town of Ashby shall be designated and known as the Burnham S. Walker Highway. Suitable markers bearing said designation shall be erected along said highway by the department of public works.
