of chapter forty-four of the General Laws, any city or town may, during calendar year nineteen hundred and eighty-two, borrow for a period not to exceed five years for the payment of charges incurred under contracts authorized by section four of chapter forty of the General Laws for the expert appraisal of taxable property or for the preparation of assessors maps; provided, however, that the remaining provisions of said section seven shall apply to such borrowing.

Chap. 58. AN ACT CERTIFYING FREDERICK A. HAAS OF THE TOWN OF SOUTH HADLEY AS AN ELECTRICAL ENGINEER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the board of registration of professional engineers, established by section forty-five of chapter thirteen of the General Laws is hereby authorized and directed to certify Frederick A. Haas of the town of South Hadley as an electrical engineer.

Chap. 59. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE USE OF CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN FUNDS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 6 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 774 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by striking out the third paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

Such committee may place such funds in a savings account or money market to earn interest thereon but may not invest its funds or other things of value in any other manner.

Chap. 60. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DARTMOUTH TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR

ACTS, 1982. - Chap. 61.

THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT
TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO TOWNE
LIQUORS OF DARTMOUTH, INC.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Dartmouth is hereby authorized to issue to Towne Liquors of Dartmouth, Inc., a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section seventeen; provided, however, that if there is an addition to the quota of such licenses in the town of Dartmouth under said section seventeen, then the license authorized herein shall become included in the new quota.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 61. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY TO SELL AND CONVEY FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES CERTAIN LAND HELD FOR CONSERVATION PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Tewksbury acting through its conservation commission is hereby authorized to sell and convey for residential purposes and for such sum as said commission deems advisable a certain parcel of land held for conservation purposes situated on Maple road and Heath street in said town and shown on assessor's Map 69, Lot 72, and is bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point on the Northeasterly side of Heath St.; thence turning and running in a Southeasterly direction along Maple Road for a distance of 75 feet more or less to a point at lot 317;

thence turning and running in a Southwesterly direction along said lot 317 for a distance of 87 feet more or less to a point at lot 271;

thence turning and running in a Northwesterly direction along
