

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 281, 282, 283.

**Chap. 281. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING A BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVAL OF CERTAIN SALARIES IN DOMESTIC INSURANCE COMPANIES.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 35 of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently amended by chapter 332 of the acts of 1979, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- No domestic company shall pay any salary or compensation to the five most highly compensated officers, trustees or directors thereof or to any additional officers, trustees or directors whose salary or compensation exceeds one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, unless such payment be first authorized by a vote of its board of directors, trustees or a committee thereof.

**Chap. 282. AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING APOTHECARY LABELLING.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 110 of the acts of 1976, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "address", in line 4, the following words:- , the filling pharmacist's initials.

SECTION 2. Section thirty-one of chapter one hundred and twelve of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

**Chap. 283. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISCONTINUANCE AND RELOCATION OF RESIDENTS WITHIN MOBILE HOME PARKS.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 32L of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 277 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by striking out subsection 7 and inserting in place thereof the following four subsections:-

7. Failure to comply with the provisions of subsections 1 to

6, inclusive, shall constitute an unfair and deceptive trade practice under the provisions of paragraph (a) of section two of chapter ninety-three A.

8. A mobile park licensee shall give at least fifteen days written notice, delivered by certified or registered mail to each mobile home park tenant, that the licensee will be appearing before a governmental board, commission or body to request a permit for a change of use or discontinuance of the mobile park. Upon a change of use approved by the governmental board, commission or body, or a change that requires no local governmental permit or permits, the licensee shall give to each mobile home park tenant at least two years written notice, delivered by certified or registered mail, prior to the mobile park licensee's determination that a change of use or discontinuance will occur. The licensee shall disclose and describe in the notice the nature of the change of use or discontinuance.

9. The mobile home park licensee shall give each prospective tenant written notice prior to the inception of tenancy that the licensee is requesting a change of use before local governmental bodies, or that a change of use has been granted, or that a change of use which requires no governmental approval will occur, noting the effective date of change of use or discontinuance.

10. Enforcement of compliance with the provisions of subsections 8 and 9 shall be in accordance with the provisions of sections four to eight, inclusive, of chapter ninety-three A. Any mobile park resident shall have the right to damages as provided in sections nine and ten of said chapter ninety-three A.

Chap. 284. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN DENTISTRY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 52D the following section:-

Section 52E. The board, after due notice and hearing, may suspend, revoke, cancel or reprimand the holder of any certificate, registration, license or authority issued by it, of any dentist whom it finds has engaged in repeated irregularities in billing an insurance company or other third party payer for services rendered to a patient.

For the purposes of this section irregularities in billing shall include: reporting charges for the purpose of obtaining a total
