

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 298, 299, 300.

Chap. 298. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BELMONT TO REIMBURSE A CERTAIN TAX PAYMENT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Belmont is hereby authorized to appropriate and to pay four hundred twenty-one dollars and twenty cents to the Christ Lutheran Church of Belmont, such sum being for reimbursement of taxes assessed on the property of the church in fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 299. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF ASSESSORS IN THE CITY OF NEWTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section twenty-four of chapter forty-one of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the mayor of the city of Newton may appoint a three member board of assessors in accordance with the provisions of its charter and shall designate one member as chairman who shall also be the director of the department of assessment administration within said city.

Whenever a member of the board of assessors serves as a professional appraiser within said department of assessment administration, he shall be subject to the direction of and report to said director of said department.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and shall cease to be operative on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.

Chap. 300. AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE FOR JOHN J. ZIMINI AS CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF CHELSEA.
