Chap. 363. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TREASURER OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY TO PAY A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The county treasurer of Berkshire county, with the approval of the county commissioners, is hereby authorized to pay, from any available funds of said county, to The Studley Press Inc. in the town of Dalton, the sum of four thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven dollars together with interest at the rate of one and one-half per cent for each month or part thereof from the date of April sixth, nineteen hundred and eighty-three, for the printing of a county development commission brochure in the calendar year nineteen hundred and eighty-three.

Chap. 364. AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE MINUTEMAN REGIONAL VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The paragraph defining "Employee" in section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 701 of the acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: - "Employee", as applied to persons whose regular compensation is paid by the Minuteman Regional Vocational Technical School District, shall mean any person, whether employed for a stated term or otherwise, who is engaged in duties which require that his time be devoted to the service of the district in each year during the ordinary working hours of regular and permanent employees.

SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 32 is hereby further amended by striking out the paragraph defining "Member", as most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 556 of
