

ACTS, 1983. - Chap. 443, 444.

SECTION 1. The bridge over the east branch of the Westport River on state highway route 88 in the town of Westport shall be known and designated as the Normand Edward Fontaine bridge, in memory of Specialist Fourth Class, Normand Edward Fontaine, who was killed while a member of the armed forces of the United States during the Vietnam campaign. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 443. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SANDWICH TO ISSUE THREE ADDITIONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Sandwich is hereby authorized to issue to Sandwich Package Store, Inc., Meeting-house Package and Variety Store, Inc., and to East Sandwich Package Store in said town, in each instance, a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said licenses shall be subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section seventeen; provided, however, that the number of seasonal licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises authorized for said town to issue under the provisions of said section seventeen is reduced by three such licenses; and provided, further, that said licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the licenses issued herein within one year after the date of issuance of said licenses.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 444. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION SKATING RINK IN THE CHARLESTOWN DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF

ACTS, 1983. - Chap. 445.

BOSTON AS THE FREDERICK DOUGLAS EMMONS,  
JOHN GERALD HARRIGAN AND MATHEW J.  
O'NEIL RINK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 544 of the acts of 1966 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- The metropolitan district commission skating rink in the Charlestown district of the city of Boston shall be known and designated as the Frederick Douglas Emmons, John Gerald Horrigan and Mathew J. O'Neil Rink, in memory of Frederick Douglas Emmons, a veteran of World War I, Seaman First Class John Gerald Horrigan and Mathew J. O'Neil.

SECTION 2. A suitable and separate marker bearing the name of Mathew J. O'Neil shall be erected at said skating rink by said commission.

Chap. 445. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY  
TO PRESCRIBE CERTAIN ELECTION FORMS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 42A of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 8A of chapter 1137 of the acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by striking out the first and second paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following two paragraphs:-

Any person claiming to have the qualifications for voting in any city or town who, by reason of physical disability, is unable to appear in person to register may make application, in writing, to the registrars of voters of such city or town for registration in the manner hereinafter provided. Application for registration under this section shall be made on forms prescribed by the state secretary and provided by said registrars.

The form of application when complete shall, not later than the third day prior to the last day for registration of voters, be returned by mail to the registrars of voters of the city or town to which such request is made. Applications received after such third day shall not be acted upon.

SECTION 2. Section 87 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 9 of chapter 386 of the acts of
