

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 110, 111.

Project costs to be financed by the issue of the bonds or notes, including notes issued in anticipation of federal or state aid, may include interest on temporary borrowing incurred for a period of up to twelve months after the date of the original borrowing. Any net earnings derived from investment of the proceeds of the bonds or notes may be expended and shall be used only for the construction, equipping, operation or maintenance of the town's wastewater treatment plant and related facilities. Except as otherwise provided in this act indebtedness incurred by the town for the project shall be subject to the applicable provisions of chapter forty-four of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 110. AN ACT RELATIVE TO FALSELY ASSUMING TO BE AN OFFICIAL OF THE BUREAU OF SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 268 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 33, as most recently amended by section 82 of chapter 233 of the acts of 1983, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 33. Whoever falsely assumes or pretends to be a justice of the peace, notary public, sheriff, deputy sheriff, medical examiner, associate medical examiner, constable, police officer, probation officer, or examiner, investigator or other officer appointed by the registrar of motor vehicles, or inspector, investigator or examiner of the department of public utilities, or investigator or other officer of the alcoholic beverages control commission, or investigator or other official of the bureau of special investigations, or examiner, investigator or other officer of the department of revenue, and acts as such or requires a person to aid or assist him in a matter pertaining to the duty of such officer, shall be punished by a fine of not more than four hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than one year.
