

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 271, 272.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provision of section four of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws or any other provision of law to the contrary, the licensing board of the city of Newburyport shall consist of five members.

**Chap. 271. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE TO IMPOSE A LICENSE FEE OF THREE PER CENT OF GROSS SUBSCRIBER REVENUES UPON ITS CABLE TELEVISION OPERATION.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section nine of chapter one hundred and sixty-six A of the General Laws, the town of Brookline may impose upon any operator of a cable television communications system within its jurisdiction a license fee of three per cent of the operator's gross revenues per year from subscribers and cable operations in said town.

SECTION 2. In lieu of the three per cent of annual gross revenues to be tendered to the town of Brookline as provided in section one of this act, for the first three years from execution of a final license to operate a cable television communications system in said town, said town may require an annual payment of not more than fifty thousand dollars per year.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 272. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYORS.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 81D of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the definition of "Land surveyor", as amended by section 3 of chapter 707 of the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following definition:-

"Professional land surveyor", a professional specialist in the technique of measuring land, educated in the basic principles of mathematics, the related physical and applied sciences, and the relevant requirements of law for adequate evidence and all re-
