

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 301, 302.

Chap. 301. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEWTON TO SELL AND CONVEY TO PAUL PATTISON CERTAIN SURPLUS LAND ACQUIRED FOR RECREATION PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Newton is hereby authorized to sell and convey to Paul Pattison, upon such terms and conditions as the city may impose, a certain parcel of open land, under the control of the recreation commission, said parcel being bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point on the southerly line of Beacon Street, distant 94.32 feet westerly of a point on the curve of said street; thence S.8° 03' 30" W, 75.00 feet; thence S.47° 28' 34" W, 38.25 feet, thence S.84° 00' 00" W, 74.00 feet, thence N.46° 09' 31" E, 155.70 feet by land of Buyer, to the point of beginning.

The above-described parcel being shown as Lot A on a plan entitled "Plan of Land in Newton, Mass., Scale 1" = 10', May 26, 1983, by Apex Associates, Land Surveyors", said plan to be recorded with the deed to this parcel.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 302. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO MAKE EMERGENCY REPAIRS ON PRIVATE WAYS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the city of Worcester is hereby authorized to make temporary repairs on private ways within its corporate and municipal limits which have been open to public use for six years or more and in such cases the provisions of section twenty-five of chapter eighty-four of the General Laws shall not apply.

SECTION 2. After a vote by the city council of the city of Worcester, pursuant to petition by at least two-thirds of the abutters thereon, that conditions exist on a private way which require temporary repairs by public necessity, the commissioner of public works of said city shall cause the temporary repairs to be made. Said temporary repairs shall include only the filling in of holes or depressions with sand, gravel, cinders or other
