
Chapter 258. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HAVERHILL TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO ACADEMY PLAZA TRUST.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the city of Haverhill is hereby authorized to issue a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages, not to be drunk on the premises, to Academy Plaza Trust under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section seventeen; provided, however, that the granting of this license shall reduce by one any increase in licenses granted due to census reapportionment under said section seventeen.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 259. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR RECALL ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person who holds an elective office in the town of Phillipston may be recalled therefrom by the registered voters of the town in the manner provided herein.

SECTION 2. Any one hundred registered voters of the town may file with the town clerk of said town an affidavit containing the name of the officer sought to be recalled and a statement of the grounds of recall. Said town clerk within five working days shall thereupon deliver to the voters making such affidavit a sufficient number of copies of petition blanks demanding such recall. Said blanks shall be issued by the town clerk with his signature and official seal attached thereto; they shall be dated and addressed to the board of selectmen of said town, shall contain the name of the person to whom issued, the number of blanks so issued, the name of the person sought to be recalled, the office from which recall is sought, the grounds of recall as stated in said affidavit, and shall demand the election of a successor to such office. A copy of the petition shall be entered in a record book to be kept in the office of the town clerk. Said recall petition shall be returned and
