

SECTION 2. Said corporation may discontinue that part of its present road which is rendered useless by said change of location. May discontinue part of present road.

SECTION 3. In locating, constructing and maintaining the railroad hereby authorized, said corporation shall have all the rights and privileges, and be subject to all the liabilities and restrictions given or imposed by their charter, or by any laws which now are or may hereafter be in force in relation to railroads. Corporate rights and liabilities.

SECTION 4. All persons who shall sustain any damage in their property by said change of location, shall have all the remedies provided by law for persons whose lands or other property is taken for the location and construction of railroads. Damages, how remedied.

SECTION 5. Such changes as are made under the provisions of the first section of this act shall be filed in the clerk's office of the county of Berkshire within one year from the time they are made. Notice of change to be filed in county clerk's office.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE CAPITAL STOCK OF THE BOSTON LEAD COMPANY. Chap. 129

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

SECTION 1. The Boston Lead Company is hereby authorized to add to its capital stock two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, divided into shares of one thousand dollars each, and to hold real estate necessary and convenient for its business to an amount not exceeding in all three hundred and fifty thousand dollars. May increase \$250,000, and hold real estate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE CAPITAL STOCK OF THE GLASGOW COMPANY. Chap. 130

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

SECTION 1. The Glasgow Company, a corporation established in South Hadley, is hereby authorized to increase its capital stock one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, the same to be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, and to hold real estate necessary and convenient for its business, to an amount not exceeding three hundred and fifty thousand dollars. May increase \$150,000, and hold real estate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
