

*Chap. 67.* AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE DANIEL W. STEVENS TO EXTEND HIS WHARF  
IN HOLMES' HOLE.

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows:*

May extend  
wharf in Tis-  
bury.

Subject to ap-  
proval of harbor  
commissioners.

Provisos.

SECTION 1. License is hereby given to Daniel W. Stevens to extend his wharf in Holmes' Hole, in the town of Tisbury, five hundred feet, and the extension shall be of the same width as the present structure: *provided*, that all things done under this act shall be subject to the determination and approval of the harbor commissioners, as provided in the fourth section of chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six; and *provided*, that this license shall in no wise impair the legal rights of any person; and *provided, further*, that this license may be revoked at any time, and shall expire at the end of five years after its taking effect, except so far as valuable structures may have been actually and in good faith built under the same.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 68.* AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE VERMONT AND MASSACHUSETTS RAIL-  
ROAD COMPANY TO TAKE LAND IN FITCHBURG FOR DEPOT AND  
OTHER PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows:*

May take land  
in Fitchburg  
for depot and  
track purposes.

Not exempt  
from taxation.

Powers and du-  
ties.

Remedy for  
damage.

SECTION 1. The Vermont and Massachusetts Railroad Company are hereby authorized to purchase, or otherwise take, so much land between Laurel and South Streets in the town of Fitchburg, including a small parcel adjoining the land of said company on the easterly side of South Street, including in all not over one acre, for depot, station or track purposes, and to construct additional tracks thereon, crossing said Laurel and South Streets at the grade thereof: *provided*, that land taken or purchased under this act shall not be exempt from taxation.

SECTION 2. Said corporation shall, in relation to such land, be entitled to all the rights and privileges, and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all general laws which now are or may hereafter be in force relating to such corporations.

SECTION 3. All persons who shall sustain any damage in their property by the taking of such land, shall have all the rights and remedies given by the general laws.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
