

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY MUTUAL FIRE INSURANCE COMPANY. *Chap. 86.*

Be it enacted, &c., as follows:

SECTION 1. The charter of the "City Mutual Fire Insurance Company," established in the city of Roxbury, is amended by striking out the words limiting its duration; and said corporation shall continue in existence with the powers and privileges and subject to the restrictions, duties and liabilities set forth in the general laws which now are or hereafter may be in force and applicable to such corporations. Charter extended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE CHARTER OF THE MERRIMACK MUTUAL FIRE INSURANCE COMPANY. *Chap. 87.*

Be it enacted, &c., as follows:

SECTION 1. The charter of the Merrimack Mutual Fire Insurance Company is amended by striking out the words limiting its duration; and said corporation shall continue in existence, with the powers and privileges and subject to the restrictions, duties and liabilities set forth in the general laws which now are or hereafter may be in force and applicable to such corporation. Charter extended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE SHERIFF OF THE COUNTY OF WORCESTER. *Chap. 88.*

Be it enacted, &c., as follows:

SECTION 1. From the first day of January of the present year, the sheriff of the county of Worcester shall receive, in quarterly payments, an annual salary of twenty-five hundred dollars. Salary fixed at \$2,500 a year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE ASSISTANT DISTRICT-ATTORNEY FOR THE SUFFOLK DISTRICT. *Chap. 89.*

Be it enacted, &c., as follows:

SECTION 1. From the first day of January of the present year, the salary of the assistant district-attorney for the Suffolk district, shall be at the rate of three thousand dollars a year, to be paid to him out of the treasury, in monthly payments. Salary fixed at \$3,000 a year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
