

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE EVANGELICAL SOCIETY IN LEOMINSTER. *Chap. 23.*

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows :*

SECTION 1. The name of the Evangelical Society in Leominster is changed to the Orthodox Congregational Society in Leominster. Name changed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE KELLOGG STEAM POWER COMPANY OF PITTSFIELD. *Chap. 24.*

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows :*

SECTION 1. Ensign H. Kellogg, S. W. Bowerman, N. G. Brown, Daniel Sprague, James H. Butler, E. D. Jones, David A. Clary, their associates and successors, are made a corporation by the name of The Kellogg Steam Power Company, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining in the town of Pittsfield, one or more buildings furnished with steam power to be rented for manufacturing and mechanical purposes ; with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all general laws, now or hereafter in force, applicable to such corporations. Corporation.  
Name and purpose.  
Powers and duties.

SECTION 2. Said corporation may hold for the purposes aforesaid, real and personal estate, not exceeding in value three hundred and fifty thousand dollars. Real and personal estate not exceeding \$350,000.

SECTION 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall not exceed three hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each. Capital stock and shares.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SOCIETY OF OBLATE FATHERS FOR MISSIONS AMONG THE POOR TO HOLD ADDITIONAL ESTATE. *Chap. 25.*

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows :*

SECTION 1. The Society of Oblate Fathers for Missions among the Poor, a body corporate, may hold real and personal estate in the city of Lowell, necessary for the purposes of the organization, to an amount not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, in addition to the estate said body corporate is now allowed by law to hold. May hold additional real and personal estate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
