

Somerville shall be at the rate of eighteen hundred dollars per annum, to be paid from the first day of April of the present year.

SECTION 2. The salaries of the clerks of the municipal court of Taunton, and of the police court of Somerville, shall be at the rate of one thousand dollars per annum, to be paid from the first day of April of the present year.

Salaries of clerks fixed at \$1,000 per annum.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION THREE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FIVE, OF THE ACTS OF THE YEAR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, IN RELATION TO BORROWING MONEY FROM SINKING FUNDS.

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hundred and fifty-five of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-three, is repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND NINETY-FOUR OF THE ACTS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HAMPDEN COUNTY TO TAKE LAND FOR COURT HOUSE PURPOSES.

*Ch. 237.*

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and ninety-four of the acts of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two is hereby amended, by adding the following words: *provided* the right to take land as aforesaid shall not extend beyond the first day of October in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE COLLECTION OF TAXES.

*Be it enacted, &c., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The fourth section of chapter twelve of the General Statutes is hereby amended, by inserting after the word "may" in the second line, the words "by a special warrant."
