

# ACTS.

## EXTRA SESSION, 1901.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL OF THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT FOR THE PRESENT EXTRA SESSION. *Chap.533*

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, to wit:—

For compensation of senators, forty-one hundred dollars. Appropriations.  
Senators, compensation.

For compensation for travel of senators, a sum not exceeding five hundred and ninety-eight dollars. Travel.

For compensation of representatives, twenty-four thousand one hundred dollars. Representatives, compensation.

For compensation for travel of representatives, a sum not exceeding three thousand six hundred and twenty-four dollars. Travel.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES OF COMMITTEES OF THE PRESENT LEGISLATURE. *Chap.534*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The sum of twenty thousand five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for expenses of committees of the present legislature, to include such expenses as may have been found necessary by the joint special committee on the consolidating and arranging of the Public Statutes, as authorized by chapter Expenses of committees of the legislature.

one hundred and eleven of the resolves of the present year, the same to be in addition to any amount heretofore appropriated for the same purpose.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 535** AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS, DOORKEEPERS, MESSENGERS, PAGES AND OTHERS OF THE GENERAL COURT FOR THE PRESENT EXTRA SESSION.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Appropriations.

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the services of certain officials at the present extra session of the general court, as follows: —

Clerks of senate and house, etc.

For the clerk of the senate, two hundred dollars, for the clerk of the house of representatives, two hundred dollars, for the assistant clerk of the senate, one hundred and fifty dollars, for the assistant clerk of the house of representatives, one hundred and fifty dollars, for the sergeant-at-arms, two hundred dollars, for the doorkeeper of the senate, one hundred dollars, for the doorkeeper of the house of representatives, one hundred dollars, the same to be in addition to the compensation now provided by law.

Chaplains of senate and house, etc.

For the chaplain of the senate, fifty dollars, for the chaplain of the house of representatives, fifty dollars, for the assistant doorkeepers, messengers and postmaster of the senate and house of representatives, twenty-four hundred dollars, for the messenger to the sergeant-at-arms in charge of the document room, one hundred dollars, for the pages of the senate and house of representatives, six hundred dollars, for the elevator men employed in the state house, six hundred dollars, and for clerical assistance to the clerk of the house of representatives, a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
