CHAP. CLIV.

An Act to revive and continue in force, an act, entitled
 “An act to establish a Corporation, by the name of
 the Woburn Turnpike Road and Dracut Bridge
 Corporation.”

SEC. 1. **BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled “An act to establish a corporation, by the name of the Woburn Turnpike Road and Dracut Bridge Corporation,” passed on the sixth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten, be, and the same is hereby revived and continued in force, for the term of five years from the passing of this act, for the purpose of enabling the persons therein named, their associates and assigns, to build and complete the said bridge over the said Merrimack river, agreeable to the provisions described in said act, any law to the contrary notwithstanding. Grant of further time.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That Josiah Brown, Esquire, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to notify and warn a meeting of said proprietors, to be holden sometime in the month of April or May next, at such place as he may appoint, for the purpose of choosing a President, Clerk, Directors, and Treasurer, and to transact any other business relative to the affairs of the said corporation, by publishing notification thereof, in one or more of the public newspapers printed in Boston, two weeks at least, before the holding of said meeting. Meeting for choice of officers.
