

CHAP. XXXIX.

An Act in addition to an Act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Trustees of the Sheldon English and Classical School of Southampton."

BE *it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,* That the Trustees of the Sheldon English and Classical School at Southampton, be, and they hereby are authorized to apply a sum, not exceeding one thousand dollars, of the funds of the said Institution, to discharge the debts of the same, incurred in the erection of suitable buildings, and purchase of apparatus for the said Institution: *Provided*, the assent, in writing, of the donors of the said funds be first obtained, and filed with the Clerk of said Corporation.

Trustees authorized to apply funds with consent of donors.

CHAP. XL.

An Act in addition to the Acts to prevent the destruction, provide a passage, and regulate the taking of Alewives, and other Fish, in Ipswich River.

SEC. 1. **BE** *it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,* That, instead of the passage ways now required by law for the fish to pass Warner's Dam and Farley's Dam, in Ipswich, the owners of the said Dams, their successors and
