

This act to be in force from and after the first day of July next.

CHAP. XLI.

An Act for the preservation and regulating the taking of Shad in Mattapoissett River in the Town of Rochester.

BE *it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That the penalties, remedies, provisions, and laws, enacted, and now in force, for the preservation of the fish called Alewives, in Mattapoissett River, in Rochester, in the County of Plymouth, and for the regulating the taking said fish in the said River, be, and the same hereby are extended to Shad in said River, and the pond from which said River issues.*
