AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FIVE DAY WORK WEEK FOR POLICE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF WAKEFIELD. *Chap. 44*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of general or special law, the services of all police officers of the town of Wakefield shall be restricted to five days in any one week; provided, that, in case of any public emergency, or of any unusual demand for the services of said police, service in excess of five days may be authorized by the chief of police, and such additional services shall be compensated for as overtime. The compensation payable to any police officer shall not be reduced by reason of acceptance of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the registered voters of the town of Wakefield at the annual town election in the current year in the form of the following question which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used in said town at said election: — "Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-one, entitled 'An Act providing for a five day work week for police officers of the town of Wakefield', be accepted?" If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act shall take full effect on May first, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, but not otherwise.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO HAVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS PREPARED FOR A NEW COURT HOUSE IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM. *Chap. 45*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing adequate court house accommodations and facilities for the first district court of Southern Middlesex in the town of Framingham, the county commissioners of the county of Middlesex are hereby authorized and directed to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for a new court house. For said purposes, said commissioners may expend such sums, not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars, as may be provided therefor in the appropriations for the current year for said county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
