Chap.289 AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WHICH THE TOWN OF STOUGHTON MAY BORROW FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 406 of the acts of 1950 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 7, the words "seven hundred and fifty" and inserting in place thereof the words: — one million two hundred and fifty, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 1.* For the purchase of land for school purposes and for the purpose of constructing and originally equipping and furnishing a school building or for an addition to a presently existing school building, the town of Stoughton may borrow from time to time within a period of five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Stoughton School Loan, Act of 1950. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit and shall, except as provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 406 is hereby further amended by striking out section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following section: — *Section 2.* Action taken under the authority of this act at the special town meeting held in the town of Stoughton on February thirteenth, nineteen hundred and fifty-one shall be as valid and effective as though this act had been in full force and effect at the time the warrant for said meeting was posted.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap.290 AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT THE TOWN OF ADAMS MAY BORROW FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 268 of the acts of 1950 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the word "five" and inserting in place thereof the word: — eight, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 1.* For the purpose of constructing a high school building, and for originally equipping and furnishing the said building, the town of Adams may borrow, from time to time, within a period of five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not ex-
