

SECTION 2. Any action taken at any town meeting by the town of Barnstable in the current year shall be as valid and effective as if this act were in effect at the time of the posting of the warrant for said meeting.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE FEES PAYABLE BY APPLICANTS FOR REGISTRATION AS HAIRDRESSERS, BEAUTY SHOPS AND MANICURISTS. Chap.427

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 87CC of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the schedule, as appearing in section 8 of chapter 565 of the acts of 1943, and inserting in place thereof the following: —
