Chap.473 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO BORROW MONEY FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Worcester may, within a period of five years from the passage of this act, incur indebtedness in an amount not exceeding two million, two hundred and fifty thousand dollars for the purpose of acquiring land by purchase or eminent domain and for the construction of a school building on the Curtis land on the easterly side of Burncoat street near Rexhame road in said city, including the cost of architectural and engineering services, and the cost of landscaping and recreational development of the site and of original equipment and furnishings for said school building, and may issue bonds or notes therefor which shall bear on their face the words, Worcester School Building Loan, Act of 1951.

Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit provided by chapter forty-four of the General Laws, but shall, except as provided herein, be subject to the provisions of said chapter forty-four, including the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof, and shall be in excess of the amount authorized by chapter two hundred and eleven of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and sixteen, as amended by chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap.474 AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION OF CERTAIN LAWS AFFECTING VETERANS AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS TO THE JEWISH WAR VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES.

Emergency preamble.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make available at once the rights granted therein to the Jewish War Veterans of the United States, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:
