

shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more than thirty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit, but shall, except as provided herein, be subject to the provisions of chapter forty-four of the General Laws, including the limitations contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF A PIER SOUTHWESTERLY OF GOVERNOR'S ISLAND INTO BOSTON HARBOR BEYOND THE ESTABLISHED LINE OF JURISDICTION. *Chap.585*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The state airport management board is hereby authorized to construct and maintain a pier for the establishment of approach lights, from available funds, at the General Edward Lawrence Logan Airport. Said pier shall extend approximately six hundred and one feet beyond line A to X southwesterly of Governor's Island, as established by chapter four hundred and eleven of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-nine. The construction and maintenance of said pier shall be subject to chapter ninety-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT ALLOWING THE SERVICES PERFORMED BY A CERTAIN PERSON IN THE BULKELEY SCHOOL OF CONNECTICUT TO BE CONSIDERED AS SERVICES PERFORMED IN A PUBLIC DAY SCHOOL WITHIN THE MEANING OF THE RETIREMENT LAW. *Chap.586*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

For the purpose of retirement in accordance with chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, the services performed by Herbert H. Archibald in the Bulkeley school of New London, Connecticut, shall be regarded, under the provisions of subdivision (4) of section three of said chapter thirty-two, as service in a public day school, and he shall be allowed to have retirement credit, as provided in said chapter thirty-two, upon payment of the required amount of money into the annuity savings fund of the teachers' retirement system.
