

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF RANDOLPH TO PAY A PENSION TO ADOLPH O. CHRISTIANSEN, A FORMER SUPER-INTENDENT OF SCHOOLS IN SAID TOWN. Chap.593

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good, and in consideration of his long and efficient service as superintendent of schools in the town of Randolph, said town is hereby authorized to pay a pension of twenty-five hundred dollars per annum to Adolph O. Christiansen, a former superintendent of schools.

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by said town of Randolph at any annual or special town meeting. *Approved August 8, 1951.*

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN PHYSICAL CONDITION OR DISEASE RESULTING IN TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY SHALL BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN SUFFERED IN LINE OF DUTY, WITH REFERENCE TO THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT LAW. Chap.594

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 94, added by chapter 551 of the acts of 1950, and inserting in place thereof the following section: — *Section 94.* Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or contributory system, any condition of impairment of health caused by hypertension or heart disease resulting in total or partial disability to a uniformed member of a paid fire department or permanent member of a police department, or of the police force of the metropolitan district commission, or of the state police in the department of public safety, or of the capitol police, or of the public works building police, who successfully passed a physical examination on entry into such service, which examination failed to reveal any evidence of such condition, shall be presumed to have been suffered in line of duty, unless the contrary be shown by competent evidence. *Approved August 8, 1951.*

AN ACT AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL BORROWING BY THE SOUTH GRAFTON WATER DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF GRAFTON. Chap.595

SECTION 1. Chapter 485 of the acts of 1948 is hereby amended by striking out section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following: — *Section 4.* For the purpose of paying the necessary expenses and liabilities incurred under this act, other than expenses of maintenance and operation, the district may borrow from time to time such sums as may
