

drinking water supply, fireplaces and tables, bathhouse, two comfort stations, together with beach improvement and grading around the bathhouse, and may authorize the necessary surveys and consulting services relative thereto.

SECTION 3. For the purposes of this act, there may be expended such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

*Chap. 608* AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ADAMS TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN SAID TOWN TO JOHN J. WALSH AND MARY G. WALSH.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The town of Adams is hereby authorized to convey to John J. Walsh and Mary G. Walsh of said town a certain parcel of land situated in said town, now used for playground purposes, bounded and described as follows:— Beginning at an iron pipe driven into the ground in the easterly line of land conveyed by Daniel E. Burnett to the inhabitants of the town of Adams by deed dated May 7, 1915. (This point is distant 238 88/100 feet southerly from the most northeasterly corner of this land, as measured along the westerly line of a right of way 16 5/10 feet wide which right of way runs southerly, southeasterly and easterly to Columbia street); thence south 150° 30' east along the westerly line of the aforesaid right of way 86 19/100 feet to a concrete monument set in the ground; thence continuing along the westerly line of said right of way south 9° 05' east 66 86/100 feet to an iron pipe driven into the ground at a point where the westerly line of Harding street, if extended southerly, would intersect the same; thence south 21° 11' west 81 05/100 feet along the aforesaid extended westerly line of Harding street to an iron pipe driven into the ground; thence north 68° 49' west 20 55/100 feet to an iron pipe driven into the ground; thence north 12° 03' west 205 64/100 feet to an iron pipe driven into the ground; thence north 74° 25' east 60 00/100 feet to the point of beginning, together with the use of the right of way, in common with others extending southerly and southeasterly from the northeast corner of parcel herein described to Columbia street.

*Chap. 609* AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF SUSAN P. MOULTON OF REVERE UNDER THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The retirement allowance of Susan P. Moulton, a former school teacher in the city of Revere, who was retired in June, nineteen hundred and forty-seven under option (c) of subdivision (2) of section twelve of chapter thirty-two of the
