

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO JOHN GRANDE. *Chap.737*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the city of Boston is authorized to appropriate and to pay a sum of money not exceeding ten thousand dollars to John Grande, father of Anthony Grande, who, on July seventh, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, received injuries while lawfully playing at the Eliot school playground, as a result of which injuries the said Anthony Grande died on July ninth, nineteen hundred and forty-nine.

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance during the current year by vote of the city council of the city of Boston, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COUNTING OF CERTAIN ABSENT VOTING WAR BALLOTS AT THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN THE CURRENT YEAR. *Chap.738*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Every official absent voting war ballot for use at the regular municipal election in the city of Boston on the first Tuesday of November in the current year, which shall have been marked and mailed in accordance with law on or before said Tuesday by a person on active duty in the armed forces of the United States and qualified to vote at such election, shall, if received by the board of election commissioners of said city after the closing of the polls at said election, but before five o'clock in the afternoon of the third Friday of said November, be deemed to have been received by said board before the closing of the polls at said election, and, if otherwise in conformity with law, be counted as if so received, except that with respect thereto said board shall exercise the powers and perform the duties conferred or imposed by law upon the warden or other officers of the polling place. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to affect any official absent voting war ballot received by said board at or before the closing of the polls at said election or to affect the filing for, or the conduct of, any recount resulting from said election.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
