

from said sum to items of appropriation for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and fifty-two, which are available in whole or in part for personal services, such amounts as are necessary to meet said salary adjustments, to be in addition to amounts appropriated to said items of appropriation of section two of chapter four hundred and ninety of the acts of the current year and of this act, and the governor, upon recommendation of the commission on administration and finance, is further authorized to allocate such transfers to the several state or other funds to which such items of appropriations are charged.

SECTION 15. The budget commissioner is hereby directed to send a copy of sections three to fourteen, inclusive, of this act to each departmental, divisional and institutional head immediately following the passage of this act.

SECTION 16. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this act, the appropriations and authorizations in this act shall become effective upon its passage.

*Chap.807* AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF QUARTERS IN THE STATE HOUSE FOR THE USE OF THE ITALIAN AMERICAN WORLD WAR VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES, INC., DEPARTMENT OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

G. L. (Ter. Ed.), 8, § 17, etc., amended.

Section 17 of chapter 8 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 190 of the acts of 1948, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "Wars", in line 8, the words: — and of Italian American World War Veterans of the United States, Inc., Department of Massachusetts.

*Chap.808* AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE PROPERTY OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY, ITS LESSEES OR TENANTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

No alcoholic beverages shall be sold on any of the properties under the supervision and control of the Metropolitan Transit Authority, its lessees or tenants.

*Chap.809* AN ACT MAKING A CERTAIN CLARIFYING AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

G. L. (Ter. Ed.), 32, § 10, etc., amended.

Section 10 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 784 of the acts of the current year, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "re-election", in the first sentence of subdivision (2) (b), the words: — or fails to become a candidate for nomination, re-election or election.
