

thereof the following two sentences: — The trustees, however, shall not fix a fare for children between the ages of five years and eleven years, inclusive, in excess of one half the regular fare for transportation of a passenger with transfer privileges. No increase in rates of fare for children or for school pupils shall be deemed to be a general increase in rates of fare under the provisions of this section or under the provisions of section one of chapter four hundred and four of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-two.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 383. AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO FURTHER REGULATE THE PARKING OF UNATTENDED VEHICLES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CERTAIN PRIVATE WAYS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 21 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause (14), as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following clause: —

(14) For prohibiting or regulating the leaving of vehicles unattended within the limits of private ways furnishing means of access for fire apparatus to any building.

Chap. 384. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE STATE AUDITOR SHALL ANNUALLY AUDIT THE BOOKS AND ACCOUNTS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 465 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended by inserting after the third sentence the following sentence: — The state auditor shall likewise audit said books and accounts at least once in each fiscal year.

SECTION 2. Such audit shall be made by the state auditor without any additional appropriation.

Chap. 385. AN ACT REQUIRING THE REAL ESTATE REVIEW BOARD IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO STATE IN WRITING THE REASONS FOR ITS RECOMMENDATIONS RELATIVE TO THE SETTLEMENT OF LAND DAMAGE CASES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 6 of chapter 556 of the acts of 1952 is hereby amended by adding at the end the following sentence: — Each recommendation of said real estate review board shall be in writing and shall be accompanied by a written statement indicating the reasons for such recommendation.

SECTION 2. The third paragraph of section 6 of chapter 403 of the acts of 1954 is hereby amended by adding at the end the following sentence: — Each recommendation of said real estate review board shall be in writing and shall be accompanied by a written statement indicating the reasons for such recommendation.
