

SECTION 2. Chapter 506 of the acts of 1962, as amended by section one of this act shall take effect upon its acceptance in a county by the county commissioners, in a district by the prudential committee or a body having similar duties, in a city having a Plan D or Plan E charter by the city council, and in any other city by the city council, in accordance with the provisions of its charter, and in a town by the selectmen.

Chap. 171. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME DURING WHICH A STAY OR SUCCESSIVE STAYS OF EXECUTION TOTALLING NINE MONTHS MAY BE GRANTED IN AN ACTION OF SUMMARY PROCESS BROUGHT TO RECOVER POSSESSION OF PREMISES USED FOR DWELLING PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 43 of the acts of 1946 is hereby amended by striking out section 2, as most recently amended by chapter 241 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof the following section: — *Section 2.* This act shall become inoperative on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.

Chap. 172. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES WHILE SERVING AS JURORS IN STATE OR FEDERAL COURTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 234 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 1A the following section: —

Section 1B. An employee of a city or town who serves as a grand or traverse juror in a federal court or in the courts of the commonwealth shall receive from such city or town the difference between his salary and the compensation he received for such jury service, exclusive of any travel or other allowance.

Chap. 173. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN TO REIMBURSE MANUEL MANOLIAN FOR CERTAIN MEDICAL EXPENSES INCURRED BY HIM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation the town of Watertown may appropriate and pay to Manuel Manolian a sum, not exceeding eight hundred and ten dollars to reimburse him for medical expenses incurred by him on account of injuries sustained in the course of his employment in the engineering department of the said town.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
