line of said lake northwesterly and southwesterly about 800 feet to the point of beginning. Being land owned by Rozenas, Cepurneck and parties unknown. Said water district and the town of Bridgewater may enter into agreements for the laying of water mains and any necessary construction of other works for carrying out the purpose of this act. Said water district is hereby further authorized to supply and sell water to the town of Bridgewater upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by said water district and town, but in the event they fail to agree upon a price, at a price to be determined by the department of public utilities.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 337. An Act placing the office of superintendent of the sanitation department of the city of chicopee under the civil service laws.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. The office of superintendent of the sanitation department of the city of Chicopee shall, upon the effective date of this act, be subject to the civil service laws and rules. Said office shall be filled as a result of an open competitive examination to be held by the division of civil service in accordance with said laws and rules.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city of Chicopee.

Chap. 338. An Act prohibiting a minor from operating any motor vehicle in which there is any alcoholic beverage unless he is accompanied by his parent or legal guardian.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 24B the following section:—

Section 24C. Whoever, being a minor and unaccompanied by his parent or legal guardian, operates a motor vehicle upon a public way, knowing that there is any alcoholic beverage, as defined in section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, in such vehicle or on his person, shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.

A conviction of a violation of this section shall be reported forthwith by the court to the registrar who shall suspend, for not less than one month nor more than three months, the license of such person to operate a motor vehicle.

Chap. 339. An Act making an appropriation for the control of the gypsy moth and the linden looper by the department of natural resources.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide for an emergency program to prevent the spread of gypsy moths and linden loopers, therefore it is hereby declared
