

- Chap. 470.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF CARRIE T. FOULKES, A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of section twelve of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, the retirement allowance of Carrie T. Foulkes, a member of the teachers' retirement system, who retired as of July thirty-first, nineteen hundred and sixty-two shall, retroactive to said date, be paid in accordance with the terms of option (a), rather than the terms of option (b) of subdivision (2) of said section twelve of said chapter thirty-two. *Approved June 10, 1963.*

- Chap. 471.** AN ACT INCREASING THE FEES FOR REGISTRATION OF BARBERS AND FOR RENEWAL OF EXPIRED CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION, AND FURTHER LIMITING THE TIME FOR SUCH RENEWAL.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 87H of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 295 of the acts of 1958, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the word "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof the word: — twenty-five.

SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section 87H, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences: — Any person holding a certificate or renewal certificate which has expired may have such certificate or renewal certificate reinstated within one year of the date of expiration upon payment of a fee of seven dollars and fifty cents. If a person fails to have such certificate or renewal certificate reinstated within said year, he shall thereafter be registered as a barber only upon application to the board for examination, accompanied by a fee of twenty-five dollars. *Approved June 10, 1963.*

- Chap. 472.** AN ACT REQUIRING THE REPOSSESSOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO RETURN THE NUMBER PLATES ISSUED TO THE FORMER OWNER.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 6B the following section: —

Section 6C. Any person who takes possession of a motor vehicle by foreclosure or subrogation of title shall return the number plates issued for such vehicle to the person in whose name such plates had been issued as owner by the end of the second day following the day on which such possession was taken. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars. *Approved June 10, 1963.*
