

Chap. 237. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STATE RECLAMATION BOARD BE ADVISORY MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE FOR CONSERVATION OF SOIL, WATER AND RELATED RESOURCES IN THE DIVISION OF CONSERVATION SERVICES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 19 of chapter 21 of the General Laws, added by section 3 of chapter 664 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking out the second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth sentences and inserting in place thereof the following five sentences: — Said committee shall consist of seven voting members and three nonvoting advisory members. The seven voting members shall include three ex officio and four appointed members. The ex officio members shall be the commissioner of agriculture, the chairman of the water resources commission, and the dean of the college of agriculture at the University of Massachusetts. The four appointed members shall be appointed by said members ex officio, as follows: — one from a list of two names submitted by the Massachusetts Association of Soil Conservation Districts, one from a list of two names submitted by the Massachusetts Association of Conservation Commissions, one from a list of two names submitted by the executive committee of the State Grange and one from a list of two names submitted by the executive committee of the Massachusetts Farm Bureau Federation. The state conservationist of the United States soil conservation service, the director of the division of fisheries and game, and the chairman of the state reclamation board shall be the advisory members.

Chap. 238. AN ACT DEFINING THE WORDS "RIGHT TO OPERATE" UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of "Repairman" the following definition: —

"Right to operate", the privilege of operating motor vehicles on the ways of the commonwealth conferred by a license issued under section eight, a learner's permit issued under section eight B, or by reciprocity to nonresidents under sections three and ten.

Chap. 239. AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN OFFICIALS NOT TO ACCEPT OR APPROVE CERTAIN PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT OR ALTERATION OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES UNLESS THEY BEAR THE SEAL OF A REGISTERED ARCHITECT OR A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 54 the following section: —

Section 54A. No officer, board or commission of the commonwealth, or of any city, town or district, charged with the enforcement of laws,
