

SECTION 3. Chapter 151D of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 3 the following section: —

Section 3A. Notwithstanding any provision of any contract or agreement entered into by the trustee of any fund authorized under this chapter, whenever such contract or agreement provides for reimbursement for any visual services which are within the lawful scope of the practice of a duly registered optometrist, reimbursement thereunder shall be made to either the registered optometrist or the registered physician of the insured's selection. Visual services, as such term appears in the preceding sentence, shall mean the optometric services ordinarily provided by registered optometrists and physicians as set forth in chapter one hundred and twelve.

Chap. 387. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RECREATIONAL CENTER IN THE NONANTUM SECTION OF THE BRIGHTON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE MONSIGNOR WILLIAM J. DALY MEMORIAL RECREATIONAL CENTER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The metropolitan district commission recreational center in the Nonantum section of the Brighton district of the city of Boston shall be designated and known as the Monsignor William J. Daly Memorial Recreational Center, in memory of Monsignor William J. Daly. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be placed thereat by said commission.

Chap. 388. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND TO THE TOWN OF DANVERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The commissioner of mental health, acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to sell and convey to the town of Danvers, at a price to be determined by the commissioner of administration, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney general, all the right, title and interest of the commonwealth in and to a certain parcel of land in said town, bounded and described as follows: — Beginning at a point on the westerly line of Maple Street, said point being N 40-05-40 W, 100.73 feet from a State Highway bound stone located S 12-47-05 W, 36.21 feet from station 21 + 54.12 on auxiliary baseline "A" of said highway layout; thence running S 49-54-20 W, 52.00 feet; thence N 40-05-40 W, 58.00 feet; thence S 49-54-20 W, 68.00 feet; thence S 40-05-40 E, 58.00 feet; thence S 49-54-20 W, 78.00 feet; thence N 85-05-40 W, 31.11 feet; thence N 40-05-40 W, 208.00 feet; thence N 49-54-20 E, 220.00 feet to the westerly sideline of Maple Street; thence S 40-05-40 E by said sideline at Maple Street, 230.00 feet, to the point of beginning.
