

*Section 25.* Such summons shall fix a day and hour of appearance for trial, and shall, except as hereinafter provided, be served by an officer authorized to serve criminal process by giving to the defendant in hand or by leaving at his last and usual place of abode an attested copy not less than twenty-four hours before the return hour, or in the case of a summons issued under a complaint of a parking violation, so called, under section twenty A or twenty C of chapter ninety, by such service or by mailing an attested copy to his last known and usual place of abode not less than fourteen days before the return day.

**Chap. 339.** AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN EXCULPATORY PROVISIONS IN CONTRACTS FOR THE REPAIR OR IMPROVEMENT OF RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES SHALL BE PRINTED IN TWELVE POINT BOLD FACE TYPE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 89 the following section: —

*Section 90.* Any provision in a contract to repair or remodel a dwelling whereby the contractor seeks by the use of any words whatsoever to preclude or exonerate himself from liability to the owner, tenant or any other person for any injury, loss or damage arising from any omission, fault, negligence or other misconduct on his part shall be printed in twelve point bold face type.

**Chap. 340.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LOWELL TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN SCHOLARSHIPS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF NURSING AT THE STATE COLLEGE AT LOWELL.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The city of Lowell may annually provide for not more than ten four-year-course day scholarships in the department of nursing at the state college at Lowell for residents of said city, the sum so required to be raised by taxation. Said scholarships shall be in addition to the scholarships authorized by chapter five hundred and seventy-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-six, chapter five hundred and thirty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-nine and chapter two hundred and sixty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty, as amended by chapter nineteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

**Chap. 341.** AN ACT CHANGING THE TITLE OF A POSITION IN THE DIVISION OF WATERWAYS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FROM ADMINISTRATOR OF PUBLIC BEACHES TO ADMINISTRATOR OF WATERWAYS AND PUBLIC BEACHES.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The title of the position of administrator of public beaches in the division of waterways in the department of public works, established by section three of chapter eight hundred and twenty-one
