

Chap. 574. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE ON INTERSTATE ROUTE I-195 AND LOCATED IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AS THE PRIVATE FIRST CLASS EDWARD J. ALMEIDA BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge on interstate route I-195 over Ashley boulevard between Weld square and Coggeshall street in the city of New Bedford shall be known and designated as Private First Class Edward J. Almeida bridge, in memory of Edward J. Almeida, the first New Bedford man to be killed in the Vietnam campaign while a member of the armed forces of the United States. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department and as authorized by the federal bureau of public roads. *Approved August 28, 1967.*

Chap. 575. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COST OF THE ANNUAL AUDIT OF THE BOOKS OF THE WOODS HOLE, MARTHA'S VINEYARD AND NANTUCKET STEAMSHIP AUTHORITY BY THE STATE AUDITOR SHALL NOT BE BORNE BY SAID AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 701 of the acts of 1960 is hereby amended by striking out section 13, as amended by chapter 276 of the acts of 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

Section 13. On or before the first day of April in each year, the Authority shall make an annual report of its activities for the preceding calendar year to the governor and to the general court. Each such report shall set forth a complete operating and financial statement covering its operations during the year. The state auditor shall cause an audit of the books of the Authority to be made at least once each year. The cost of such audit shall not be borne by the Authority. Such audits made by the state auditor shall be conducted on a completely independent basis from the Authority and shall be deemed to be public records within the meaning of chapter sixty-six of the General Laws.

Chap. 576. AN ACT AUTHORIZING CARDINAL CUSHING GENERAL HOSPITAL, INC. TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Cardinal Cushing General Hospital, Inc., a corporation organized under chapter one hundred and eighty of the General Laws, is hereby authorized to hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding twenty million dollars, to be used for the purposes of said corporation as set forth in its charter or certificate of organization or in any amendment thereof. *Approved August 28, 1967.*
