

SECTION 2. For the purposes aforesaid, the treasurer of the county of Bristol, with the approval of the county commissioners thereof, may borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Bristol County Agricultural School Loan, Act of 1968. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell the said securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

SECTION 3. The county treasurer, with the approval of the county commissioners, may issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not more than one year from their date, in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds or notes under this act, but the time within which such serial bonds or notes shall become due and payable shall not, by reason of such temporary notes, be extended beyond the time fixed by this act. Any notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds or notes shall be paid from the proceeds thereof. *Approved March 4, 1968.*

Chap. 31. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES CARRYING A CERTAIN CRANE OR BOOM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 19 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence, inserted by chapter 259 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — No motor vehicle, trailer or other vehicle, carrying a crane or boom whether or not permanently or temporarily attached to said vehicle or trailer, which crane or boom extends more than four feet beyond the bed or body of the vehicle or trailer shall be operated or drawn on any way unless vehicles approaching from the rear are protected from the rear projecting crane or boom by another vehicle following immediately behind the projecting extremity of such crane or boom.

Chap. 32. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REPORTING OF USED CAR SALES BY CERTAIN LICENSEES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 57 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 103 of the acts of 1952, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence: — All sales of second hand motor vehicles made by any person required to be licensed by this section shall be reported to the registry of motor vehicles in the manner prescribed for *Class 1* licensees as provided in section fifty-eight, and all such sales shall be subject to the provisions of sections sixty through sixty-nine, inclusive.
