

Chap. 80. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TERMS OF OFFICE AND QUALIFICATIONS OF LOCAL SUPERINTENDENTS OF PEST CONTROL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 13 of chapter 132 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 7 of chapter 657 of the acts of 1956, is hereby further amended by striking out the first three sentences and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences: — The city manager and the town manager in cities and towns having such a manager, otherwise the mayor in cities and the selectmen in towns, shall appoint for a term of three years a local superintendent of insect pest control, hereinafter called the local superintendent, for the suppression of the public nuisances named in section eleven. Said local superintendent shall be qualified by training and experience to enable him to carry out efficiently the powers and duties of his position, and shall possess a supervisory license issued under the rules and regulations of the pesticide board in the department of public health.

Chap. 81. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE RIGHTS OF BAHÁ'Í'S SPIRITUAL ASSEMBLIES RELATIVE TO SOLEMNIZING MARRIAGES AND RELATIVE TO CERTAIN RELATED MATTERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 30 of chapter 207 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 197 of the acts of 1946, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 15 and 16, the words "chairman of an incorporated local spiritual assembly" and inserting in place thereof the words: — authorized representative of a Spiritual Assembly.

SECTION 2. Section 38 of said chapter 207, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 11 of the acts of 1965, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 22 and 23, the words "local spiritual assembly of the Baha'is according to the usage of their society" and inserting in place thereof the words: — Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is according to the usage of their community.

SECTION 3. The third sentence of section 39 of said chapter 207, as appearing in chapter 54 of the acts of 1965, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the words "chairman of a spiritual assembly" and inserting in place thereof the words: — authorized representative of a Spiritual Assembly.

SECTION 4. Said chapter 207 is hereby further amended by striking out section 40, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 11 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

Section 40. Every justice of the peace, minister, rabbi, secretary of a Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is, leader of an Ethical Culture Society, and clerk or keeper of the records of a meeting wherein marriages among Friends or Quakers are solemnized shall make and keep a record of each marriage solemnized by him, or in such meeting, and of all facts relative to the marriage required to be recorded by section one of chapter forty-six. He shall also, between the first and tenth days of the month following each marriage solemnized by him, return each certificate issued under section twenty-eight to the clerk or registrar who issued the same; and, if the marriage was solemnized in a town other than the place or places where the parties to the marriage resided, return a copy of the
