

**Chap. 237.** AN ACT REQUIRING OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO DELIVER NUMBER PLATES TO THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOLLOWING REVOCATION OF THE REGISTRATION OF SUCH MOTOR VEHICLE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The first sentence of the first paragraph of section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "certificate", in line 6, the words: — and number plates. *Approved May 8, 1968.*

**Chap. 238.** AN ACT REDEFINING THE TERM "OWNER-REPAIRMAN" AS USED IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the definition of "Owner-repairman", inserted by section 3 of chapter 511 of the acts of 1948, and inserting in place thereof the following definition: —

"Owner-repairman", any person who is not a manufacturer, dealer or repairman, and who owns a fleet of ten or more motor vehicles or trailers which are used by him exclusively in his principal business, and who maintains an establishment with facilities for the repair, alteration or equipment of such motor vehicles or trailers.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine. *Approved May 8, 1968.*

**Chap. 239.** AN ACT EXCLUDING CERTAIN POLL TAKERS FROM THE OPERATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 6 of chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section (p) the following subsection: —

(q) Services performed by an individual as a poll taker or opinion taker, if the rate of such individual's remuneration is determined by a person other than the person supervising him and if said individual is free to accept or decline any given assignment.

**Chap. 240.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETURNS BY ASSESSORS OF NAMES OF CERTAIN CORPORATIONS AND ASSESSED VALUE OF CERTAIN CORPORATE PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 83, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 490 of the acts of 1958, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

Section 83. The assessors shall, upon request of the commissioner for detailed information concerning domestic and foreign corporations named by the commissioner, except banks of issue and deposit, having a capital stock divided into shares, organized for the purposes of business
