

second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — He shall charge as a liability fifty per cent of the amount of the premiums written in its policies of ocean marine insurance upon yearly risks, and upon risks covering more than one passage not terminated, or the actual unearned portions of such premiums, and shall require a reserve to be carried equal to one hundred per cent of the premiums on trip risks written during the month ended as of the date of statement, except that in the case of a foreign fire and marine company with less than three hundred thousand dollars capital, admitted to transact fire insurance only, he shall charge as a liability the full amount of premiums written in its marine and inland navigation and transportation insurance policies.

**Chap. 328.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING FRATERNAL BENEFIT SOCIETIES TO INVEST IN SHARES OR DEPOSITS OF CERTAIN CREDIT UNIONS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 40 of chapter 176 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 238 of the acts of 1960, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "commonwealth", in line 5, the words: — , in shares or deposits in credit unions insured by the Massachusetts Credit Union Share Insurance Corporation.

SECTION 2. Chapter 540 of the acts of 1958 is hereby amended by inserting after section 2A, added by chapter 155 of the acts of 1961, the following section: —

*Section 2B.* Any fraternal benefit society transacting business under authority of sections forty-five to forty-six D, inclusive, of chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the General Laws, as in effect immediately preceding the effective date of this act, may invest its funds in shares or deposits in credit unions insured by the Massachusetts Credit Union Share Insurance Corporation.

**Chap. 329.** AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE MASTER OR KEEPER OF A JAIL OR HOUSE OF CORRECTION MAY EXPEND TO AID CERTAIN DISCHARGED PRISONERS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 165 of chapter 127 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "ten" and inserting in place thereof the word: — twenty-five.

**Chap. 330.** AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROCESSOR'S LIEN RELATIVE TO SYNTHETIC FIBERS AND CERTAIN OTHER MATERIALS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 31A of chapter 255 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — A lien on account of work, labor and materials furnished in the spinning,
