

for such purpose such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, sixty thousand dollars from the amount available in item 8902-34 of section two of chapter four hundred and fourteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-seven; provided, that no claim for such damage shall be paid under the provisions of this act for any poles, wires, pipes or other public utility facilities located within the limits of any public way under any grant, license or permit.

Chap. 344. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BUILDING AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 2 of chapter 773 of the acts of 1960, as amended by section 3 of chapter 684 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by striking out the first six sentences and inserting in place thereof the following:—

The Authority shall consist of nine members to be appointed by the governor, of whom three members shall be appointive members of the trustees, and may, but need not, be graduates of the University, and three other members shall be graduates of the University. The members appointed from the appointive members of the trustees shall continue in office so long as they continue in office as trustees, and such dual membership shall not invalidate any action heretofore or hereafter taken by the Authority or by the trustees in which any such member has participated or may participate. Each member appointed other than from the appointive members of the trustees shall continue in office for a term expiring on June thirtieth in the sixth calendar year next after the calendar year in which his term of office began, except that a person appointed to fill a vacancy in any such membership shall serve only for the unexpired term. Each member shall continue in office until his successor shall have been appointed and qualified, but the term of office of a member appointed other than from the appointive members of the trustees shall be deemed to have commenced in the calendar year in which the stated term of office of his predecessor shall have expired. Any member of the Authority may be removed by the governor for cause after notice and a public hearing unless such notice and hearing are expressly waived in writing.

SECTION 2. All members of the University of Massachusetts Building Authority in office on the effective date of this act shall continue in office until their respective terms of office expire or they earlier die, resign or are removed. Members of said Authority thereafter appointed from the appointive members of the trustees shall be so appointed that not more than four members of the Authority shall at any one time be members who were appointed from the appointive members of the trustees.

Chap. 345. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE LOWELL TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE BUILDING AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 2 of chapter 557 of the acts of 1961, as amended by section 3 of chapter 685 of the acts
